

#### Timely Maintenance Requests Are Critical

We've recently seen an increase in residents not reporting important maintenance issues as soon as they notice them-especially water leaks or moisture problems. Please remember, your lease requires that you promptly report any water leaks, electrical issues, or other conditions that could pose a risk to health, safety, or property.

Delays in reporting these issues can lead to costly damage and may affect your lease standing. Failure to notify management in a timely manner could result in eviction or ineligibility for lease renewal.

If you see something, say something—your cooperation helps protect everyone's home.



#### **Preventing Mold & Mildew in Your Apartment**

- To help maintain a healthy home environment and prevent mold or mildew buildup, please follow these important guidelines:
- HVAC Use: Always set your HVAC fan to Auto. Running the fan without heating or cooling can push moisture back into the air, which can lead to mold or mildew growth in your apartment or ductwork. It also causes filters to clog more quickly, making your A/C work harder and increasing your electric bill.
- (Reminder: Filters should be changed every 30 days—free replacements are available in the laundry room.)
- Window Condensation: Open your curtains or blinds regularly and wipe down any moisture from condensation, especially if you use blackout curtains. Condensation is normal around windows but requires occasional cleaning and ventilation to prevent issues.
- Bathroom Ventilation: Always run the bathroom exhaust fan while showering to reduce humidity. If you notice moisture buildup around the fan or ceiling, wipe it down as needed. ### **Trash Compacter/Dumpster Rules**

- Compactor is for bagged trash only. Do not dispose of boxes inside trash compactor.
- Cardboard boxes should be broken down and placed inside the dumpster labeled "CARDBOARD ONLY"
- No bulk items can be left on-site. All furniture or large/bulk items should be taken to the landfill. Any bulk items left at the compactor will incur a \$50 fee for pick up.
- DO NOT press any buttons on the compactor unless there is a need for an emergency stop. The compactor runs automatically. Simply open the door, throw in the trash, close the door and walk away!
- Do not leave any bags or boxes outside of the compactor.
